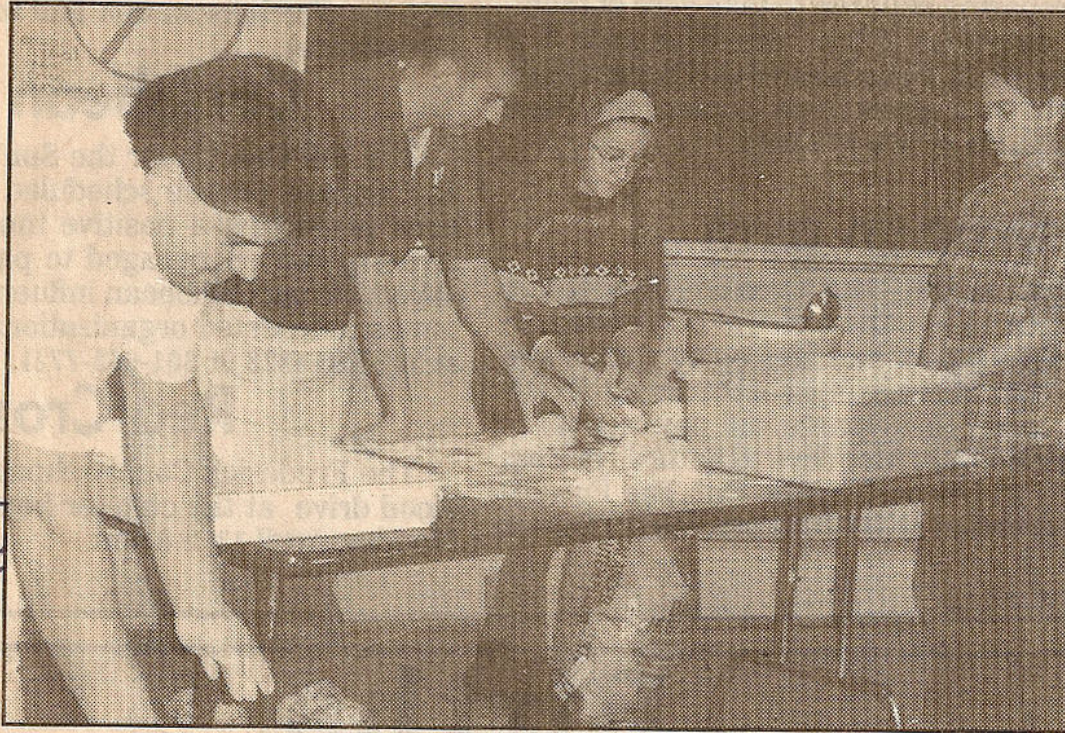


# Pizza restaurant owner visits class
